SMALL GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

The less credit I take, the more credit God gets and the more credit God gives.

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

Read Matthew 6:1-4. What is Jesus warning against in this passage? What expectations does Jesus have of His followers in this passage? What promises does Jesus make in this passage?

Read Matthew 6:3-4 five times and meditate on its meaning. What is Jesus' point in these verses and what are some ways Christians can practically follow this teaching today?

2. ASSESS YOUR LIFE

One thing Jesus regularly railed against was hypocrisy. We know it is wrong, but it is often hard to see/discern in our own lives. Review Pastor Micah's explanation and the different types of hypocrisy. Where can you see hypocrisy in your own life?



God the Father sees everything – every action, every thought, every emotion I have. What does He see in your heart when it comes to serving and giving for Him? (at church, at home, at work, at school, etc...)

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

Jesus isn't against giving, but He wants us to give with the right heart attitude. Think about various times and ways that you give. What is your heart attitude in these various times of giving? How can you move your heart attitude to be more about reflecting Jesus than other lesser motives?

4. COMMIT THIS WEEK

What is one thing you need to do or continue doing this week to move the focus of your serving or giving off of you and more on to Jesus? This could be with others or even within your own heart.
