SMALL GROUP APPLICATION QUESTIONS

Jesus didn't come to just solve your problems, but rather to save your soul.

1. REVIEW THE SERMON

Read Matthew 21:1-11. What made Jesus' entry into Jerusalem significant? What was Jesus trying to communicate by entering this way? Why did the people respond the way they did to His entry?

What were the people's expectations of Jesus? What clues in the story show their expectations? How did this compare to Jesus' purpose and plan?

2. ASSESS YOUR LIFE

What need in your life first made you seek Jesus for help? How did Jesus respond to that need? How did His help with that need impact your relationship with Him?



Jesus didn't come to help us win at this life, but to help us win at new life. Where have you seen this truth in your own life? When has Jesus allowed you to suffer through something in this life in order to help grow or mature you spiritually? How did this impact your view of and relationship with Jesus?

3. APPLY THE TRUTH

Although Jesus' primary purpose is to help save us from sin, He also loves to help those who follow Him with other areas as well. However, sometimes we seek His help for a comfortable easy life more than for spiritual formation and growth. What are some ways or areas of your life where you tend to seek Jesus' help for the former more than the latter? Why do you think you do this and what can you do to correct it?

4. COMMIT THIS WEEK

There are many people around us every day who desperately need Jesus to help rescue them from sin and eternity in hell. Who will you pray for and invite this week to come and experience help from Jesus on Easter Sunday?
